

Nonprofit Hub Expanding in 2018

Lincoln, NE: A local coworking space announced plans today to rebrand and expand in 2018.

Starting in January, the Nonprofit Hub building at 211 N 14th Street will be known as Foundry, and will expand to street-level with additional collaboration space and a retail coffee bar, committing to give all profits to the nonprofit sector.

“We’ve always subscribed to an Impact Pact, allowing for-profit businesses to work from the space as long as they’re positively impacting the community. But we quickly discovered our brand was limiting to the type of collaboration we’re interested in doing. Changing the name to be more inclusive allows us to reach more people trying to make a difference in our community,” said Randy Hawthorne, executive director of Foundry and Nonprofit Hub.

Nonprofit Hub will remain an “anchor” member of the building, continuing to provide education throughout the country and to local nonprofits.

Revo, the social impact incubator, will also remain housed at Foundry, established to help businesses seeking to become benefit companies.

Additional services will be added in 2018 with the help of a grant from Woods Charitable Fund. A student resource center will be established to offer services to nonprofits and provide real-world experience to university students, particularly in the areas of marketing, accounting and law.
