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TOP LEADER LEVELS



The Foundry community has identified two critical sponsorship opportunities. These levels are our highest level of sponsorship with the most significant impact.

TALENT LEADER



Foundry Talent Leader level sponsors directly support the Intern Foundry (IF) program - an initiative designed to make a positive dent in Nebraska's Brain Drain and provide purpose-driven organizations with critical capacity. Talent Leaders understand that sponsoring high-skill interns (for your organization and/or in support of nonprofits) helps Lincoln and Nebraska retain critical talent through meaningful connections and, at the same time, builds a long-term, robust ecosystem of community impact.

CAPACITY LEADER

Foundry Capacity Leaders empower the Foundry Community by sponsoring one monthly community impact lunch for up to 50 individuals focused on a strategic topic of interest and impact in Lincoln. Capacity Leaders can name a meeting room or common area space at the Foundry for one year (renewal possible) for maximum branding. Naming a conference room at the Foundry and sponsoring a community impact lunch propels the purpose-driven ecosystem to advance through collaboration and community.
